

Thank you for your interest in Desert Edge Montessori. We are proud to bring 2 exceptional Montessori programs to Southern Utah which includes our Private school that provides private Preschool and Kindergarten for students age 3-6 and our State Licensed Childcare program that provides full time childcare and education to children ages 2-6. Both programs are located in the same building but on different sides-Two exceptional programs under one roof, so that we can best meet the needs of not just the little ones in our community-but also the needs of their “grown ups”. We are a company that is committed to serving children, their families and our community. Our director is licensed by the AMS (American Montessori Society) and has over 10 years experience working with children in this community and now families don't have to choose between exceptional care and exceptional early childhood education. They are both available-just choose which program that will best work for you!

General Information on our fully State Licensed Childcare Program



Desert Edge Childcare is licensed with the state of Utah and is an exceptional childcare service for children who are ages 2-6. Childcare is located on the left hand side of the building. Children are required to be fully potty trained upon enrollment into our childcare program. At this time we only enroll a maximum of 20 students into our full time childcare program. Enrollment into our exceptional program is based on availability only and will be on a first come first serve basis. We do compile a waiting list so be sure to ask to be placed on this-if we are “full” at the time of your enquiry. Childcare will be provided to families for 8-9 hours per day or for 40 hours per week. Tuition for childcare will be the same each month-even if your child misses a day etc. We do not offer an hour by hour service-nor do we offer a pro-rate for days missed or provide part time childcare at this time-etc. We are a company that is committed to providing as stable environment as possible for our students and this is one of the ways we try to provide that. In addition all students who enroll in childcare will be required to enroll for a minimum of 6 months at a time. We do not offer a month to month childcare program. Childcare hours are Monday-Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. All students enrolled in childcare need to arrive no later than 9:00 am-so as to not disrupt the classroom morning routine. We are an education based care center and we want to eliminate possible distractions or disruptions for the children that are here learning while being cared for. So plan to drop off anytime between 8:00 am and 9:00 am-and keep your late arrivals very minimal. Remember you are choosing us-because we are providing something different and better than some of the other options out there. We do not offer childcare services on Saturday or Sunday. Childcare will not be provided on all bank holidays, National holidays, the day before Thanksgiving- Thanksgiving day, Christmas Eve-Christmas Day, New Years Eve and New Years Day. In addition to these scheduled closed days-the building will be closed the last week of each May for routine annual cleaning, repainting-repairs and general maintenance and during the first week of August each year so that the staff can participate in their mandated training and required Montessori recertification. During the last week of May and the first week of August they will not be childcare provided. These scheduled “off” days are part of our program and will not change the amount of tuition that will be due these months etc. Please be aware of them before enrollment. We are committed to providing a clean and safe environment that is beautiful and updated for our students and their families, in addition we are committed to maintaining high standards in regards to our staff and their training and these mandated closed dates are one of the ways we maintain our high standards of care. All students who enroll in childcare will be required to provide a daily lunch from home-we do not participate in the state food program. We want our students to eat from healthy options and to be able to enjoy the foods from home that they are most comfortable with. We do not at this time allow squeeze fruits, go-garts or lunchables. The squeeze fruit and go-garts have been nationally recalled due to mold issues in them more than once and we have no way of verifying if the food inside is healthy and safe that your little one is eating-and lunchables are not a healthy option for a child to eat every single day. Healthy snacks are provided to children in childcare services 3 times each day-but these are not meal replacements. Please make sure that your little one is being offered a healthy breakfast and provide a healthy lunch from home for them each day. If a child is still eating their breakfast in the morning upon drop off-you may bring them with that. More information on this can be given during your tour or upon enrollment.



A little about us and our staff:

Both of our programs are designed to meet the needs of students for two to three years. Because it is not uncommon for a student to stay with us for such a time period, we are an intimate school. Our class sizes are small so that we can meet the personal needs of each of our students as well as really get to know each student and their parents. It is not uncommon for us to have a younger sibling of a past student. Our Childcare program is limited to a total of 20-24 spots, with 2 lead teachers and 1 Director and 1 Co-Director. Childcare is located on the right side of the building and is separate from the school side-which is found on the left side of our building. In our school classrooms we enroll 30-35 students per session, per day. This means each morning session we will have 30-35 students and each afternoon session, we will have the same. In our school classroom we have four main teachers and our director-not including any volunteers or interns. Our teaching staff on both the school side and the childcare side has, been trained in traditional Montessori, and full time members have completed a 6 month long internship. We are committed to Montessori standards, practices and principals and most of all-we love what we do and we love our students. In addition to having such an amazing and committed staff, we work with students in our community from Dixie State University who are currently enrolled in their Early Childhood Education program, whom come in to complete volunteer hours, study Montessori and whom are looking to begin their career in Early Childhood. These volunteers are regular members of our team and have been background checked and screened by both ourselves and the college. This program is one way that we “give back” to the community and we are proud to partner with Dixie University to offer this opportunity to their students.



Student Enrollment Contract for Admission into Desert Edge Childcare



Our Childcare Program is for full day Monday-Friday. We do not enroll part-time children in our childcare program, due to the high competitiveness of our program. Availability is on a first come, first serve basis. Our childcare is open Monday-Friday from 8:00 am – 6:00 pm. Students can be dropped off anytime between 8:00 am and 9:00 am-but must try to be here no later than 9. Repeated tardiness after 9:00 am is discouraged in order to limit disruptions to our classroom setting and Morning Community Time. Remember, we are more than a “regular daycare”. We are providing an educational experience for your child, in addition to providing excellent care for them. Pick up time is anytime between 3:15-5:00 pm. Families can choose from 3 main options for enrollment. Option 1: 8:00 am -6:00 pm is \$600 a month and Option 2: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm is \$550 a month. Option 3: 9:00 am -3:30 is \$500 a month. We also offer dual enrollment into our sister school next door-for children whom are 3 or older and want to attend preschool as well as receive childcare. They can attend school during school hours and childcare outside of school hours. It’s a great “win win” for many families. If this is an option you are interested in, please speak to our director. At this time the earliest time for student drop off is 7:45 am and is only available for students selecting Option #1. This helps us maintain proper student ratios. Students must be picked up on time according to the plan they enroll in. You may not assume that you can just change this or be late-We are serious about maintaining ratios and staff according to enrollment plans Students picked up later than their scheduled time will be charged a \$25 dollar daily late fee per the first offence and \$30 for the second and so forth offence. We promise to open on time and hope you promise to pick up on time-both of us being mutually respectful of each other’s time. When Parents are late it often requires the Center to have to pay a staff member overtime-which can add up or it throws off our state mandated ratios.Plus think how frustrating it would be to have us open late-It would not be ok-so let’s be mutually respectful of both our time.

We are a state licensed childcare center and do enroll students whom get assistance or subsidiary payments from the State to help pay for their childcare expenses. Sometimes this will require families pay weekly while they are in the application process. This is the only time we accept weekly payments. If you want to avoid having to pay this upfront while you are waiting for your state application to be processed we recommend applying for assistance in advance. It can take up to 2-3 weeks for applications to be processed. If you apply please select Desert Edge Childcare as your provider when it asks for this part on your application. Do not put the name of our school. School is not covered by the state-so you need to put the right information down. If you get approved for childcare help from the state a co-pay from families may be required from the state. The state does not always cover the total cost for childcare-it will depend on your application and your financial situation. We are required by DWS to collect this co-pay. However if you can not afford to pay your co-pay we have a program that allows parents to donate time, service or other goods in exchange for all or partial of their co-payment, if one is required.

All children enrolled in childcare are required to bring a daily lunch from home. The childcare center will provide a healthy snack 3 times each day, enrolled students take a turn providing the morning snack for one week every 25-24 weeks, depending upon total student enrollment. Your student is spotlighted during this week. More information will be given on this upon enrollment. The childcare center is closed for every bank holiday, the day before Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, New Years Eve and New Years day and during the 1st. week of August and the LAST WEEK OF MAY. The staff takes the first week of every August off for training/recertification/vacation etc. During this time we also deep clean/repaint/and do general maintenance on the building and grounds. No refund, credit or tuition break will be given for these mandated closure dates from the monthly tuition due. We feel that in being upfront about these dates-that families have plenty of time to make arrangements for care on these dates outside of our center. In addition these closure dates are part of our program-so please be aware of them and prepare for them before you enroll.

Childcare tuition is a monthly expense. We do not offer an hour rate, daily rate or weekly rate. We are not a month to month childcare center. Enrollment will be for 6 months at a time. Your contract will automatically renew for another six months, if written notice is not given 30 days before your renewal date. Childcare is \$600-500 per month, per student-dependending upon what hours of care or enrollment option you select. TUITION IS DUE ON THE FIRST DAY OF EVERY MONTH AT DROP OFF. YOU CAN NOT DROP YOUR STUDENT OFF AND BRING IT BACK AT PICK UP TIME. In the past we have had moms who abused our tuition policy and would drop off their student without paying and then someone else would pick them up and we had to “chase” tuition down. We will not do this. Please pay at the time of drop off and be ready for this. You can pay tuition with cash-check-card. Credit cards are charged a \$12 processing fee. Checks are made out to Desert Edge Childcare.

Every student is required to bring a package of wet-wipes at the first of the month. This will be communal and will be used for diapering and for messy hands, faces etc. Everyone shares wipes. You are required to bring an extra change of clothing to the center to leave here for staff to change your child into if they require a clothing change.

All students will also be required to purchase a center shirt to wear on Wednesday’s and for any center outings etc. Center shirts are \$15 each. If you lose your shirt or require a new one at any time, you will have to pay this fee again. We currently enroll children whom require mostly full time daycare services between the hours of 8:00 am – 6:00 pm Monday-Friday. Childcare is not available on Saturday or Sunday.

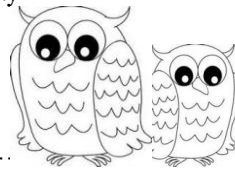

Desert Edge Childcare Medication Policy

NO MEDICATION WILL BE GIVEN AT TO STUDENTS AT OUR CENTER-unless it is a life saving medication such as an asthma inhaler or Epi-pen. If your child requires the use of an asthma inhaler or epi-pen you will be required to provide one to stay here at the center. It needs to be current and legally prescribed for your child. In addition you will need to provide a current written prescription for one AND a step by step instruction from the prescribing provider stating step by step for how the inhaler or epi-pen is to be used.

IF YOUR STUDENT IS SICK OR BECOMES ILL OR IS CURRENTLY ON A MEDICATION OR WILL NEED ONE (LIKE AN ANTIBIOTIC)

If your child is or becomes sick, keep them home please. If they are on a daily medication, it is your responsibility to administer it to your child, out of the childcare center and off our grounds. For obvious liability and legal issues we will not allow any medication/prescriptions etc. into our center. Our staff are not medically trained or authorized to administer any medication to any enrolled child etc. If your child becomes ill and requires an antibiotic or other medication-let your provider know that your childcare center does not allow or administer medication and they can usually prescribe one that can be administered by you-within the hours that your child is with you. We also feel that if your child is sick enough to need medication each day, they probably need to be home with you until they are better. If any child becomes ill or comes to our center sick, we will contact parents/guardians immediately and it will be their responsibility to come and pick up the child and take them home. If you are contacted that your child has become ill and you need to come pick them up, you need to arrive within 15-20 minutes. Can you imagine if we called a parent and reported that their child had a fever-how harmful it would be if that parent did not show up for an hour or so? We both want to keep your child healthy and safe-so lets work together-even if it becomes an inconvenience for a "working parent". We get it-we are working too-but healthy kids, must be a priority. If at ANY time your child begins taking any medication-this includes an antibiotic-WE NEED TO KNOW. Even if it is being administered to them at home or outside the hours of our care. If your child comes down with a side effect or allergic reaction to the medication, we need to be able to notify doctors/EMT's etc. in the event that the reaction or side effect becomes emergent, etc. Let us know. Report any new medication your child begins taking to us, at once. In addition to this, any child that gets injured, whether serious or minor, will have their parents/guardians contacted immediately. Parents/guardians won't always need to come and pick up their child for minor injuries etc. But we want parents to make that decision, so we will notify you and let you decide. Anything that is going on with your child, we want to make sure we are communicating clearly to you. If at any time you have any concerns, questions or comments, please let us know and together we will reach a solution.

See the information below to review what this policy is and why we have it. ☺



If there is a unique circumstance in which one or more of the parents can not have access to the child, **we need to be made aware of now.** If there is anyone else that can pick up your child from school, we must be notified by you the morning of, **in person.** We will **NOT** release the child to anyone except the parent, unless prior arrangements have been made. We will **NOT** accept a phone call from you, unless it is an emergency, or prior notification has been given. In that case a password **MUST** be given by the person picking up your child, **AND** proof of **picture ID** will be taken. If the person coming to pick up your child does not have **BOTH** the password and picture ID, your child will **NOT** be released. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!** You must choose a password. If a password is not given, we will **NOT** release your child. This is for your child's protection as well as ours. We all have emergencies come up, but your child's safety comes first. Please notify the person picking up your child of these conditions. Even if We know them or they have picked up your child before, this step must and will be done each time there is an occurrence. We appreciate your commitment to follow this rule and your support in keeping your child.

What do we do in the event of a natural disaster or emergency?

If there is a emergency like fire or flood we will evacuate the children, by walking them in an orderly manner to the large black gates attached to Doug's Auto Care (located across the parking lot). We call this our "Safe Spot" and when we do fire drills or flood drills etc. this is where we practice getting too, with the children. In the event of a real emergency, we will notify parents/guardians as quickly as we can and you will come and pick up your child there. If we have to relocate after an disaster, like what happened on 9/11 in New York, our relocation site is the Santa Clara Library located on 1099 N Lava Flow Drive, St George UT 84770. Our center has never had to relocate-but we want families to know that we are prepared in the event that we need too-and we want to provide you with the information.

Do you know where to locate our Policies and Procedures?

All other policies and procedures that we have in place for our center can be viewed by looking through our "Policy and Procedure" binder, found in the classroom. This binder may NOT be removed from the building, but is has been placed where you will be required to daily "sign your child in" and "sign them out"-so that you may review it at any time. If you wish to review it, you may do so quietly, in the classroom. If you want to know about a specific policy or procedure, you may ask us at any time and we will let you know. It is your responsibility to make sure that you understand and know all of the policies and procedures before enrolling your child. A good time to go over these is during your initial tour of our facility.

Student Photo Policy:

We take photos of all students and use these photos in training, on our website, social media etc. We do not generally share private information about the children-other than their first name. We do not take inappropriate or demeaning photos of any child etc. We also send parents texts of their children and of their children's work etc. Sometimes parents/guardians can miss certain childhood "milestones" like "first lost tooth" of the "first time they write their name" etc. we try to capture as many of these moments as possible and share them with you.

We also have school performances and take trips to the library and have amazing people in the community (like the firemen) come into our center and talk to the children etc. We will record/photo these moments. Other volunteers/parents and families in the audience of school/center student performances, will too. It is impossible to think that we could control every camera in an audience-so be aware that it is our policy to take photos etc. This means your child's photo or photo of their artwork/classroom work etc will be taken while they are in our center. These are the sole property of Desert Edge Childcare LLC and Desert Edge LLC. No we will not pay you or offer any compensation to you for using photos of your adorable children on our website etc. Yes, we had a parent a few years back, ask us this. If this is a huge concern to you, this center will not be a fit for you. Another situation we had a few years ago, was a parent who did not want ANY photo of her child to be taken-can you imagine how this child felt learning all of the Halloween songs and when it came time to being able to participate in the Annual Halloween program-they were not allowed too. We could not realistically stop every parent or grandparent etc from recording/photographing the event and posting their own photos on Facebook etc. So this child got left out-which upset them, the other students and us. It was a situation we don't hope to deal with again. We never want a child to feel left out because of something like this again-
